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## SENIORS

**Commencement (graduation ceremony) is scheduled for Sunday, June 4, 2017, at 2:00 PM.** Seniors must have at least 40 credits to participate in Commencement; must also be in "good standing" with attendance and behavior to participate; must have earned at least 35 credits to receive tickets and a seat assignment.

Senior orders (caps, gowns, tassels, etc.) will be delivered during lunch to NAHS Wednesday, April 26, 2017. Final payment is due this day. **Josten's will not accept checks for payment.** Seniors must have a Josten's cap, gown, and tassel to participate in Baccalaureate, Class Night, and Graduation.

## SCHOOL SAFETY:

Students who are being dropped off at school by car in the mornings should be dropped off in the car rider line, which is along the sidewalk leading up to Door 1. Please do not cut through or stop in the parking lots to drop off students. This is a safety hazard and causes traffic issues for others.

The regular school day at NAHS begins at 7:00 AM. Students should not expect access to the building prior to that time. The day ends at 2:26 PM. Any student remaining at NAHS after bus dismissal must be under the direct supervision of a teacher, staff member, or coach. While waiting for rides, students must wait at door 1. Students may not remain in the school, unsupervised, waiting for an event to begin later in the evening.

Please have a plan in place for your child in the rare instance of an emergency early dismissal of school.

## ISTEP/ECA'S

For students who are currently in 10th grade, the State of Indiana requires students to pass the ISTEP exams to be eligible for a high school diploma. For students who are currently in 11th or 12 grade, the State of Indiana requires students to pass End of Course assessments. If you have questions about your child's status on the exams, please contact his/her counselor.

## PROM

Prom is Saturday, April 29, 2017, from 7:30 PM—10:30 PM at the Mellwood Art Center, 1860 Mellwood Avenue, Louisville, KY. Students attending the Prom must be in school the full day on Friday, April 28, 2017. Other criteria to be eligible to attend Prom has been shared with students in homeroom and attached to the daily announcements, and includes grades, attendance, and behavior. Prom Guest Permits were due earlier this week. Any junior or senior attending the Prom should have picked up and returned a Guest Permit if the guest is a NAHS sophomore or if the guest attends or graduated from another school. Prom Tickets will be sold April 24-April 25 in the Bookstore before and after school and during lunch. Tickets are \$30 each, and may be purchased with cash, debit card, or credit card.

### Checks are not accepted.

After Prom will be at New Albany High School. Enter at Door #7, from 11:00 PM—2:00 AM. The cost is \$5 (or \$10 at the door) and After Prom tickets may be purchased at the same time Prom Tickets are purchased. Students in grades 11 and 12 who do not attend Prom, may attend After Prom.
